Dear Parents, Students, and Staff:

The Oxford Board of Education is pleased to once again offer healthy meals provided by ***Maschio's Food Services, Inc.*** for the 2009-10 school year.

Lunch service begins on **September 2, 2009** – opening day menu includes Big Daddy's Pizza, Tossed Salad, Fruit and Milk. Lunch prices will remain the same as last year:

Student Lunch	\$2.15	(includes milk)
Reduced Lunch	\$.40	(includes milk)
Adult Lunch	\$3.50	(includes milk)
Extra Entrée	\$1.65	
Milk	\$.50	

Students will once again be able to purchase prepaid meals in increments of 5, 10, or 20 meals. We will also be offering a discount on the prepaid purchase of 20 lunch tickets. To take advantage of this discount, you ***must*** purchase 20 lunch tickets for \$41.00, a savings of \$2.00. A prepaid lunch ticket order form is enclosed and is also available on our website. Checks should be made payable to the "Oxford Township Board of Education – Cafeteria", and please write the student's name on the memo line. Please place the check and form in a sealed envelope with the student's name and homeroom written on the outside. Checks should be given to either Mrs. Miller in the Main Office or the student's homeroom teacher. You may also mail your check to the school. *Please make sure lunch tickets are purchased in advance.*

The Oxford Board of Education participates in the **National School Lunch Program**. This program sets the caloric content, fat, and portion size of all meals served in the school. Under this program, students are required to take three (3) of the five (5) lunch components offered.

Student's that qualify for either free or reduced price lunch are allowed one complete meal, including milk, each day under the program. Additional meals or entrée's may be purchased at the regular price. Snacks and ice cream are not included in the free and reduced program, but are available for purchase. Free/Reduced lunch applications are sent home the first day of school. *You need only to return one application per household and only if you wish to apply for the program.* Free/Reduced lunch does not begin, until the application is returned and approved.
