

Jammin Jellies

Purpose of this activity is for the students to review the information they have learned about jellyfish and their movements.

Objectives:

Students will...

- > Discuss what they have learned about jellyfish and their movements
- > Imitate the movements of the jellyfish to music

Equipment:

- > Hula Hoops
- > Crepe paper (cut into strips and hung on the hoops)

Set up:

Crepe paper is cut into strips and hung off of the hula hoops to represent tentacles. Each student gets a hoop and steps inside holding the hoop at their hips.

The Game:

The students move the hoops and their bodies to music demonstrating various movement patterns and rhythms. This is an activity that will incorporate movement and rhythm.

Evaluation:

The game is used as a beyond activity in the M.A.R.E. curriculum. The game reviews the information covered in the curriculum and checks to see if the students understand the information. Success is measured by the behavior of the students with the hoops.
