Classroom Rules:

Homework:

Homework is important because it is valuable in helping students make the most of their experience in school. Homework is given to reinforce what has been taught in class, to prepare students for upcoming lessons, to teach responsibility and organizations, and to help develop positive study habits.

- Homework is due the day after it is assigned. (5 points)
- HW may be turned in one day late (3 points), but will be accepted after that time
- All **tests** must be signed, regardless of the grade. Tests will be included in Friday Folders and should be returned on Monday with the Friday Folder.
- A **homework blog** will be posted each day. Parents and students can check the blog each day for reminders and daily assignments. The link will be on Mrs. Kimball's homepage.

Friday Folder:

A Friday Folder will be sent home every Friday with completed and/or graded work. Grade sheets for language arts will also be included with a Friday Newsletter. The newsletter will include information about upcoming projects, assignments and/or tests.

Absent:

If you are absent, it is your responsibility to get the missed work. I will gather your LA assignments and send them home with your "homework buddy" or a sibling or you may pick them up in the office.

Extra Credit:

Extra Credit will be available for students who wish to improve their grade. Only students with a 90% or higher HW average are eligible for extra credit work.
