Admission Criteria:



STUDENT WILL BE ENTERING Kindergarten — 8th Grade in September 2012. The student must have attended school in the sending district for at least one full year immediately preceding enrollment in a choice district. (KG is an exception).



COMPLETE the application process.



FILE THE "NOTIFICATION OF INTENT TO ENROLL" FORM WITH YOUR RESIDENT DISTRICT. Forms are found from the School Choice link, www.oxfordcentral.org

All Student applications will be evaluated on an individual basis.

WHY OCS?

⇒ **Small Class Sizes:** We currently average 17 students per homeroom. This allows for personalized attention and instruction to meet a child's individual needs.

⇒ **No cost to parents:** Students attend free and parents may be eligible for transportation aid from their resident district. **Bright Students!**



⇒ **Strong Support:** The Board of Education has consistently provided the resources to maximize the opportunities for our students.

⇒ **Small school setting:** Our rural, small school provides an atmosphere that develops bonds between teachers and students.

⇒ **Quality clubs and activities:** Students may participate in many clubs and activities such as Kindergarten Soccer and our Nationally-Recognized Archery Team.

⇒ **High test scores:** OCS students have outperformed the state NJASK average in all areas.



⇒ Our students score higher on NJASK tests than other NJ districts in our factor group.. **Two computer Labs**

⇒ In 2011, 74% of our 4th and 8th grade students scored proficient or advanced proficient on the NJASK in math.

⇒ 98% of our 4th and 8th grade students scored proficient or advanced proficient on the NJASK in Science.

⇒ 87% of our students in grades 3-8 scored proficient or advanced proficient on the NJASK in Language Arts.
