

TRANSFERS/ WITHDRAWALS

General

All transfers into the schools of the district shall be in accord with file code 5111R—Admission. Students transferring into the district are expected to present copies of records from the previously attended school (or district) to aid in placement. Also required are proof of immunizations and proof of identity.

Parents/guardians of pupils or adult pupils transferring from the district shall notify the principal in a timely manner of their intention to leave the district.

Student records shall be transferred between chief school administrators within the time frame prescribed by law.

Any student, who transfers to the Oxford Central School from a school that has not met annual yearly progress, as outlined in the federal No Child Left Behind legislation, will have their records reviewed for accurate grade placement.

The chief school administrator shall ensure that the district complies with all requirements of federal law and the state department of education. He/she shall prepare regulations to implement this policy.
